What are good words to use when signaling to a co-worker that an immediate threat is present and that they call for should help?

A: Colors make good code words for signaling various threats. Code Red means there's a fire in the facility, Code Black indicates a bomb threat, Code Silver refers to weapons on site or a hostage situation, and Code Gray suggests that there is a combative or violent person at the worksite.
